# Pure BEAUTY

No parabens, sulphates, or phthalates in the bunch—just awesome, wedding-worthy results

**1** Kjaer Weis mascara (\$38) is so smooth that lashes stay feathery whether you create a barely there or doe-eyed look. (And it won't smear when tears fall.) **2** Ilia lipstick in Strike It Up (\$26) is a true red that morphs into a lovely stain as it wears. **3** Refresh post ceremony with Rootfoot Rose Water (\$15), which is chock-full of vitamin C to boost your bridal glow. **4** RMS calls its concealer "Un" Cover-Up (\$36) for a reason: It contains coconut oil that melts into skin for seamless coverage. **5** Prep with Korres Pomegranate Mattifying Primer (\$33) to tighten pores and give makeup staying power. **6** Priti NYC nail polish (\$15) has the—ahem—prettiest variety of pinks, nudes, and peaches that don't streak. The chic shade here is English Miss. **7** Start using Tammy Fender Skin Tone Brightening System (\$185), like, yesterday and you might not even need foundation for your wedding. It lightens dark spots, improves radiance, and prevents damage. So good.
